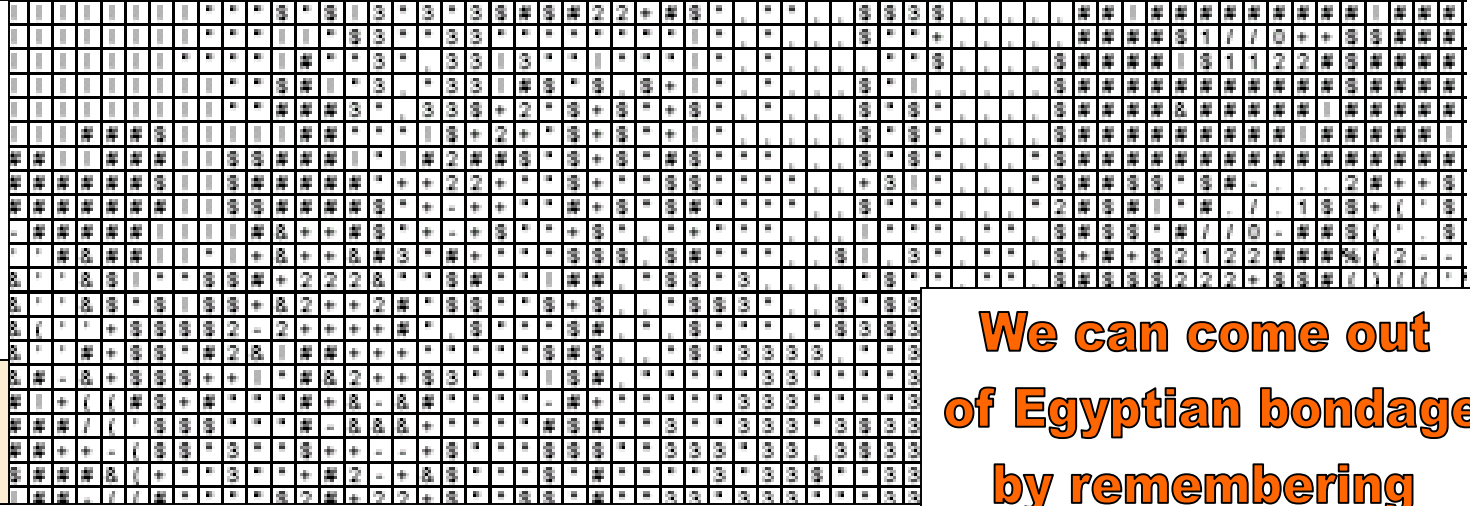
1. Archer, one knee on the ground
